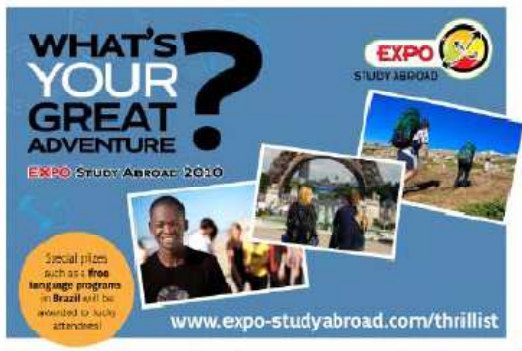




# EXPO Study Abroad 2010
